Touch of Class & Sound Dimension are the two top choral ensembles at Joplin High School.

Students learn not only a complete competition show which they compete with in the Spring, but over the course of the entire year they learn a lot of music, including "legit" repertoire. They sight-read, compete at Solo & Ensemble, audition for Honor Choirs, and represent the school as part of its premiere performing ensembles around the community. Both Show Choirs have REQUIRED evening rehearsals from 6:30-8:30pm beginning the last week of August and lasting through the end of competition season in March.

Touch of Class meets most Monday evenings.

Sound Dimension meets most Tuesday evenings.

Absences

It is important to note that all rehearsals, whether in class, after school, on weekends, as well as all concerts and competitions are REQUIRED and count as a grade. Very few things count as an excused absence.

Your absence impacts our team. If you miss a rehearsal, you may be removed from the upcoming performance or even the entire song.

PLEASE MAKE NOTE

★ THIS IS A YEAR LONG CLASS, TWO SEMESTERS. ANY STUDENT WHO JOINS SHOW CHOIR AND DECIDES TO QUIT THE CLASS AND CHOIR AFTER THE SCHOOL YEAR HAS BEGUN WILL STILL BE OBLIGATED TO PAY THE \$400 FEES AND WILL BE SUBJECT TO A FAILING GRADE IN THE CLASS.

What a Competition Show Costs

Approximate cost per show:

- \$300-400 costuming per person x 50
- \$300-500 rights per song x 6
- \$400 -750 arrangement per song x 6
- \$3000 choreography
- \$500 additional supplies
- \$5,000 transportation
- \$3,000 hotel
- \$10 show shirt per person x 50

Total \$30,700- \$39,000 times 2 shows!! Dues cover just \$17,500 of the cost of a show.

Approximate cost per student:

- \$800
- -\$400 fees
- \$400 to raise per student!!

Fundraisers are important! Your participation is required.

The Invitational (makes about \$25,000) and Just Desserts help us meet these costs.

Seek out sponsors to sponsor one or more days on the May 2023 calendar. Whatever day they sponsor, that is the amount they donate to you to go toward your show choir fees of \$400. If they sponsor May 16, they donate \$16. You only need the first 28 days sponsored in order to pay all of your fees for the 2023- 2024 school year. Days 29-31 will go toward our general fund and activities account to help cover other expenses outside our what student fees cover.

Show Choir Shirts

Show Choir shirts will be given to each student as part of their dues. These shirts will be required to be worn **UNALTERED** at each show choir competition we attend as part of their uniform for the day.

We hope to give them to members by the end of the camp.

Parents and other supporters will be given an opportunity to purchase shirts through the Boosters at a later time.

Makeup & Hair

- ★ Realize that makeup for both ladies and men are exaggerated for performances.
- ★ The directors have the final say on how hair will be worn during Show Choir competitions and outings. Please refrain from any drastic hair changes during show choir season, including unnatural hair coloring.
- ★ We hope to have a Makeup Parent and a Hair Parent who travel with us and assist with making sure everything is as it should be.

Post-Performance Expectations

 \star After performances, each student is responsible for gathering all items of their costume together and hanging them up appropriately.

★ Student who do not have their complete costume may not be allowed to perform.

Please read it in its entirety so you are aware of all policies.

★ Expectations at Competitions

1. Be respectful of other groups when they are performing.

2. <u>DO NOT</u> talk about other groups at the competition.

3. You may not leave a school building without the permission of the directors.

4. You may not have cell phones out during other schools performances5. Try to sit in the same general area when watching other groups. 6. Proper dress code will be followed when not in performance attire. We will adhere to the Joplin High School Dress Code Policy. Show Choir Shirts will be worn **UNALTERED** at each competition.
7. No PDA at any time no matter how "in love" you are.

8. Win and lose with grace and dignity- every time.

9. Refrain from posting negative or disrespectful comments on social media.

★ Traveling rules and guidelines

1. Students are expected to follow the Joplin High School Code of Conduct.

2. Trip participants are expected to show respect for others and their belongings.

3. Parents will be contacted if discipline problems occur.

4. If a discipline problem is severe, the student will be sent home at the expense of the parent.

5. It is important that all instructions are followed at all of our destinations.

6. Students are expected to cooperate and be respectful of chaperones throughout the trip.

7. Participants are expected to be prompt at all meals and departures.

8. Everyone will be responsible for his or her own luggage and personal items.

9. Students are reminded to be patient and flexible.

10. Students must realize that there will be <u>no</u> <u>tolerance</u> for anyone breaking the drug and alcohol policy.

11. Parents are expected to be prompt when picking up their child. Any student who is still waiting after 20 minutes may lose traveling rights.

IX. INTERNET

Remember that the way you represent yourself on the internet is just as important as the way you represent your group on a daily basis. Do not post any remarks towards other groups on social networking sites and always represent JHS choirs to the best of your abilities. Videos of Performances: Please refrain from posting videos of the show choirs on outside social media pages. Posting on our Facebook page where membership is restricted is fine, however, we would like to keep our shows private to protect the integrity of our students and their hard work as well as to prevent from committing any copyright infringement.

XIII. Member Conflicts

Member conflicts should be resolved by the show choir members involved. In the extreme case that the conflict affects the group, the directors will step in to help resolve the issue. If the issue cannot be resolved both members will be suspended until a resolution can be met. If you become the center of drama in the show choir you will be asked to leave. Choir is supposed to be fun and foster a supportive environment!

XIV. Eligibility

It is the expectation of the teachers that every member of the group maintains passing grades in every class. Students must be enrolled in at least 6 JHS classes including choir not including transitions. Students are only allowed one failing grade or they can not be allowed to compete. (Students only enrolled in only 6 classes have to be passing every class). The directors will check grades prior to each performance and/or competition, and only those with passing grades will be allowed to travel with the group.

XV. Chaperoning

Chaperones are need for the various competitions. Parents are encouraged to chaperone throughout the year. If you would like to be a chaperone please contact the booster club president or vice president. You may be asked to pay for your bus and lodging based on the trip.

We are required to have one chaperone per 20 students, and in most cases you must ride the bus.

Please consider being a chaperone: it is vital to our success at competitions that we have parent helpers as the directors are taking care of a thousand other things!

XVII. Group Positioning

Group performing positions are determined by the directors and the choreographer. Requests to change partners or positions by students or parents will not be entertained. We place the performers in key positions and we will make any adjustments that we feel necessary.

XIX. "In The Spotlight" Show Choir Invitational

It is a requirement that each student work at this event on both Friday evening and Saturday. It is an expectation that each student has one parent or guardian volunteer and work a minimum of 2 hours either on Friday evening or Saturday. **But of course, working more than the minimum is highly appreciated.**

XX. Lettering in Show Choir

Students will have the opportunity to letter in Show Choir each year. The first year they will receive a letter "J". The years following they will be awarded at pen to place on that letter. The requirements for lettering in JHS Show Choir are listed on the form attached.
